BBH 119: Behavior, Health, and Disease

Principles of health promotion, disease prevention, and treatment of acute and chronic illness.

Nursing 111: Nursing Roles

Introduction to nursing roles/process with emphasis on societal norms and multicultural influences on health care needs.

Nursing 112: Health Patterns/Nursing Interventions

Emphasis on individual health patterns and selected nursing interventions.

Nursing 114: Nursing Care during Childrearing Years

Emphasis on infancy through young adulthood with common and well-defined health problems, with integrated nursing content.

Nursing 197H: Scholarly Writing in the Health Sciences

Explore, in depth, scholarly writing in the health sciences.

Nursing 200W: Understanding and Applying Nursing Research (Face-to-Face, Online and Hybrid)

Introduction to methods and philosophy of empirical inquiry as applied to research in nursing and application to practice.

Nursing 212: Pathophysiology II: Nursing Interventions

Caring for middle-aged adults with acute/chronic alterations in metabolism, reproduction, oncology and immunology.

Nursing 216: Clinical Immersion II: Introduction to Concepts of Leadership

Clinical immersion course focusing on patient care and clinical seminars to develop leadership and clinical competencies.

Nursing 251: Health Assessment (Face-to-Face and Online)

Designed to broaden the student's knowledge and skills in health assessment and physical examination across the lifespan.

Nursing 297A: Medication Calculations for Nurses

Application of various methods to safely calculate dosages of medications, including basic conversion ratio and proportion, dimensional analyses and other formulas for accurate dosage calculations.

Nursing 352: Advanced Health Assessment for the Registered Nurse (Online)

This course enhances the RN student's knowledge base with more advanced techniques of interview and examination. The course demands higher-level thinking about complex health assessment challenges and prepares RN students for health assessment study at the graduate level.

Nursing 390: Transition and the Professional Role (hybrid)

Transition to baccalaureate education and professional nursing practice, emphasizing leadership, management, and issues influencing nursing education and practice.

Nursing 401: Concepts of Health (hybrid)

Exploration of current and ancient concepts of health and their respective modes of intervention.

Nursing 403: School Health and Emergency Care of Children and Adolescents

This course will provide techniques for higher levels of care for school health and emergency situations such as seizures, head injuries, sports-related accidents, falls, musculoskeletal injuries, allergic reactions, abdominal trauma, medical conditions, and more for children and adolescents. The course will provide participants with application based education including hands on instruction and return demonstration

Nursing 417: Family and Community Health Concepts (Hybrid)

Study of the concepts of family and community based nursing care emphasizing multicultural influences on health practices.

Nursing 464: Dying and Death (Hybrid)

Explores attitudes toward death and dying; concept of grief; responsibilities to the dying person and the family.

Nursing 465: Health Concepts for Adults with Complex Health Care Needs (Hybrid)

In-depth study and application of the theoretical principles and roles of adult clients and families with complex healthcare needs.

Nursing 475: Integrated Concepts in Nursing Practice (Hybrid)

Project-based capstone course for application of nursing concepts to health promotion/disease prevention in populations.

Nursing 497D: Men's Health Issues

Overview of major health issues concerning men today with an emphasis on social, cultural, and health care influences.

Nursing 497D: Compassionate Counseling for Children and Adolescents dealing with Dying, Death, and Other Life Crises (Graduate Course)

Exploring issues involving death occurring in today's world and strategies designed to help children and adolescents deal with dving, death, and other life crises.

Nursing 597A: Promoting Healthy Lifestyles for the School-Age Population (Graduate Course)

This course will focus on promoting healthy lifestyles for the school age population. The most prevalent health problems of the school age population include issues of physical inactivity, nutrition, and obesity; physical health problems of asthma, diabetes, and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder; and mental health problems of depression, eating disorders, and substance abuse. This course provides a broad overview of these health problems and discusses the role of the school nurse as a partner with families to promote a healthy lifestyle for the child.
